Digital skills are increasingly important in today's society; they can help contribute towards active ageing. This became particularly clear in the Corona pandemic: people were only able to meet virtually, for longer periods; suddenly, all educational opportunities were completely transferred to the digital world. It seems more and more obvious that only those who have the appropriate digital skills will be able to actively participate in the society of the future.

In the SenGuide project, we want to empower older learners to create their own digital learning content and share it with others.

What exactly does that mean? Many seniors would like to exchange ideas with others about their interests and hobbies, share their knowledge and learn from others. But when face-to-face meetings are not possible, as happened in the pandemic or due to limited mobility, there remains the option of meeting virtually. However, many are initially overwhelmed by the idea. We want to empower older learners to digitally prepare their personal content and share their knowledge and expertise with others who are interested.

Products that we will develop in the course of the project:



- We show you how to write your content and stories and share them on the web.
- Learn from the comfort of your own home at your preferred learning pace - All you need is a web browser.
- The content of the learning units focuses on e-learning, creating multimedia content (photo, video, audio) and sharing your contributions on the Internet.
- We are developing an additional learning module to help you to write your texts, especially for online use.



- We are planning to conduct a study with two experimental groups testing different LMSs.
- Based on the results, the LMS will be specifically tailored to the needs of older learners.
- We plan to disseminate the results on a national and international level.



- These are created by senior citizens for senior citizens.
- They deal with a wide variety of topics related to the lives of senior citizens.
- They will be available in several languages
